It gives me immense pleasure to present the annual report of MES Senior Secondary Central School Tirur, for the year 2021-2022. Our school, one among the most prestigious and popular educational establishments present in Kerala, is a ladder to bestow the flairs to gleam into vibrant shades. The school which had a humble beginning in 1990 with 5 staff and 55 students has now reached the pinnacle of glory in a span of 30 years. The foresightedness and astute leadership of our beloved Chairman, Mr Anwar Sadath Kalliyath and Secretary Mr Abdul Kader Sherief, has helped us to transmit their optimism in the school's journey in to the heights of glory.

The school is managed by the Muslim Educational Society emphasizing three predominant principles namely faith, knowledge and service, by holding on to secularism and cosmopolitan values. The powers and responsibilities are subjugated at various levels such as Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary, Senior Secondary and IGCSE. The MES fraternity consists of school governing body (SGB), Chairman, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Principal, H.M's, Office superintendent, a team of dedicated teaching and non-teaching staff.

Unlike other years, this year commenced with the gates of our campus closed and we only had technology to rely on for the teaching learning process, to stay connected and to support each other till 31.Octobe 2021.

Even in the midst of the difficult times, we were able to organize a successful transition, among our staff before the start of the academic year. We were well versed with various online platforms like Zoom, Google meet and well equipped with the use of Google Classroom and Telegram. We resumed the offline sessions of senior classes on 1st November 2021.

The online platforms were introduced to the students, and it was made familiar and comfortable so that they could become more independent in their learning. We provided quality education and strengthened the teacher/ student communication via online classes, video lessons, interactive sessions with student responses and teacher feedbacks.

MONTESSORY HOUSE OF CHILDREN

IGCSE

Our school made a conscious decision to implement the IGCSE curriculum in 2014 to keep abreast with the international benchmarking and standards par excellence. During the current academic year we had only class X, headed by Mrs Sujatha Prem. Our school is recognized by PEARSON EDEXCEL, London- UK. This year's IGCSE batch is the last batch and we decided to close the session.
